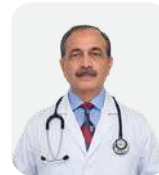

- Abstracts may be submitted by postgraduate students
- (MD, DM, MS, MCh), faculty members and PhD scholars.
- The presenting author must be registered for NAMSCON 2026.
- The presenting author should be listed as the first author.

Requirements

- Maximum 300 words for Original Research; Maximum 250 words for Case Series.
- The title should not exceed 20 words.
- Maximum 6 authors per abstract for Original Research and 4 authors for Case Series.
- Do not include tables, figures, graphs, or references.
- Use standard abbreviations only and should be defined at first use.
- Ethical approval details should be mentioned wherever applicable.

Review Process

- Abstracts will undergo blinded peer review.
- The Scientific Committee reserves the right to allocate accepted abstracts to either Oral Paper or Poster Presentation categories.

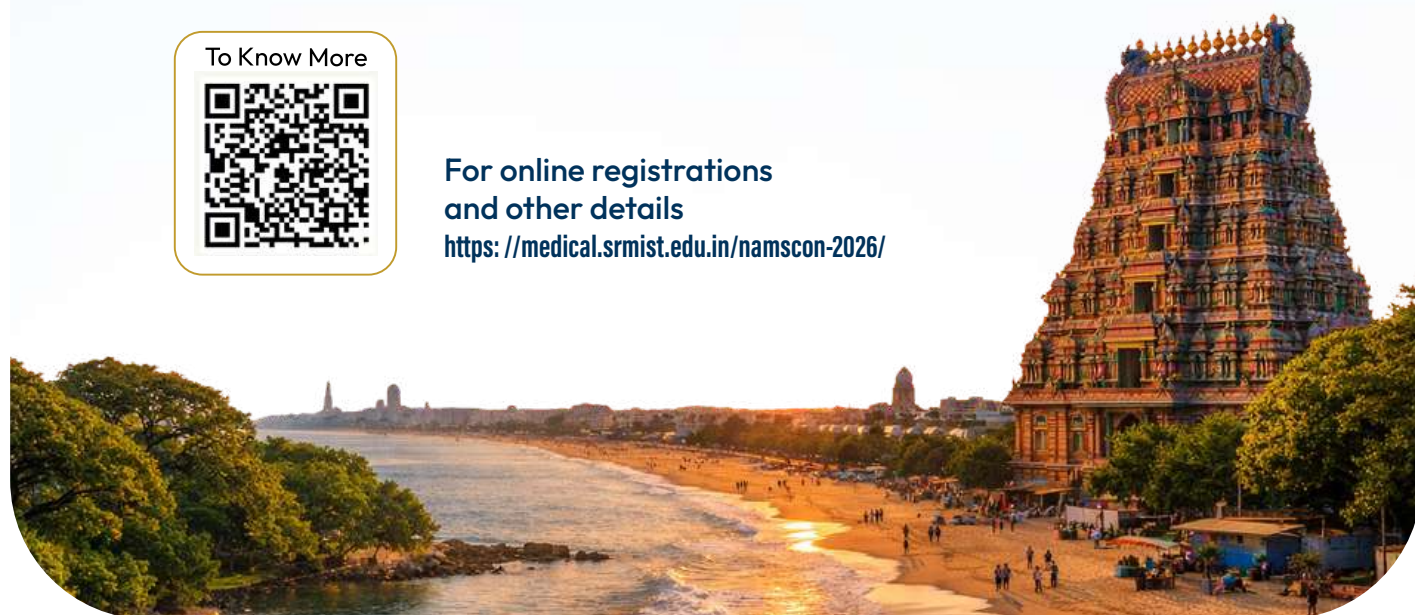
